Dear Friends and Ministry Partners:

I want to give you an update on the Vollmer Foundation (the Mission work in Zambia) and my current health status and condition. As many of you know, I endure a terrible accident with my E-bike August 31st of this year (2025). In this crash, I suffered a serious injury to my spinal column. After emergency treatment, I spent a month in ICU at West Virginia University hospital. Additionally, I spent another month in physical rehabilitation at the same hospital. I finally arrived at home in Ironton, Ohio and have spent a month getting adjusted to my condition and beginning my journey to wellness.

I'm still unable to use my arms or legs but I will recover completely by the promises of God. The accident, however has caused us to make some financial decisions. I am unable to substitute teach because I'm in a wheelchair. Sue has decided to retire and help take care of me. We are now living on social security, but we are fully committed to funding the Christian school and the foster home in Zambia, Africa.

I'm asking all of my friends and contacts on Facebook to consider a one-time gift for the mission work in Zambia. Even better, if possible, monthly support would keep the work progressing until I recover.
